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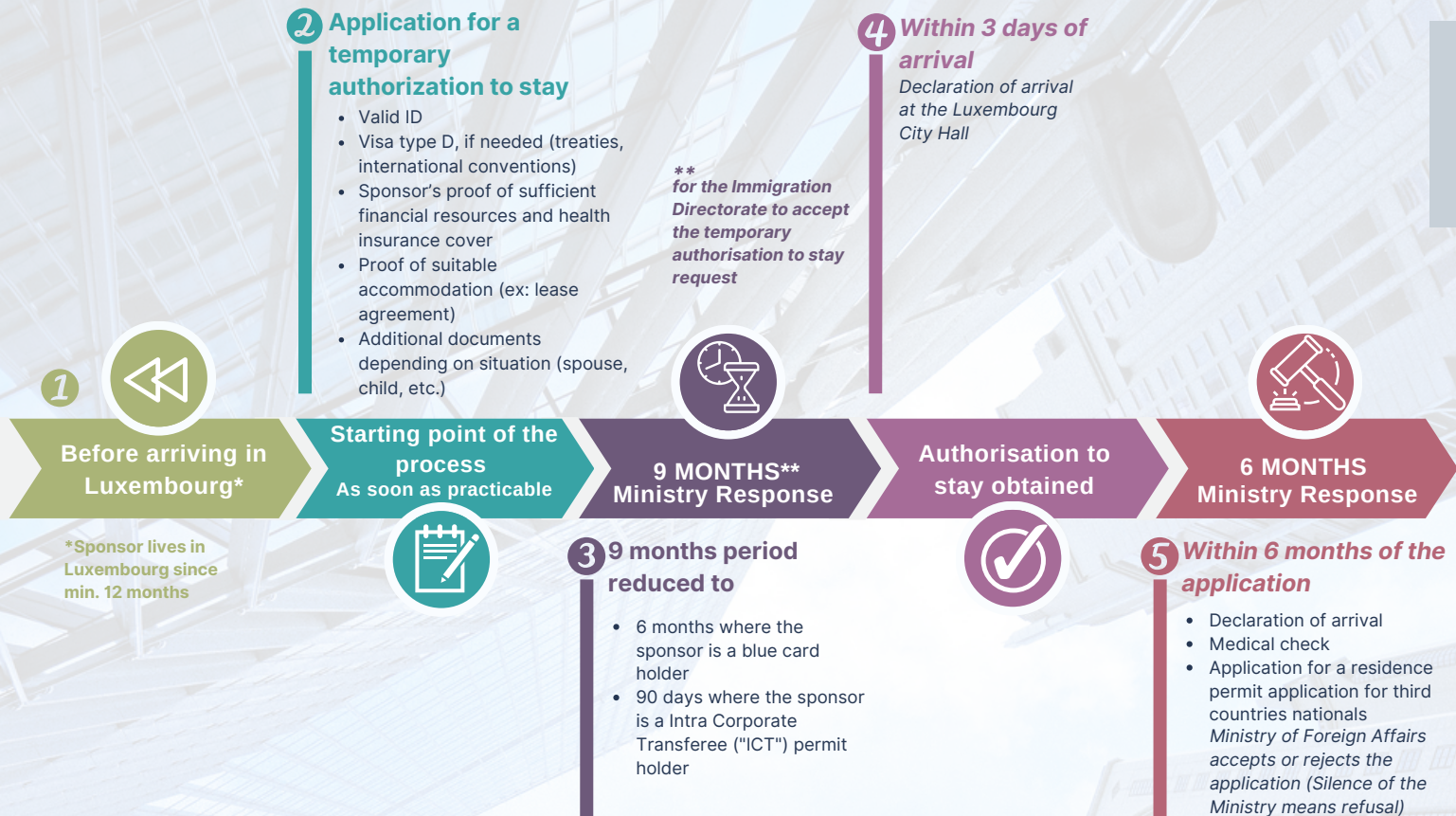
Third country nationals living in a third country and willing to come and work in Luxembourg



Third country nationals living in Luxembourg and willing to work in Luxembourg



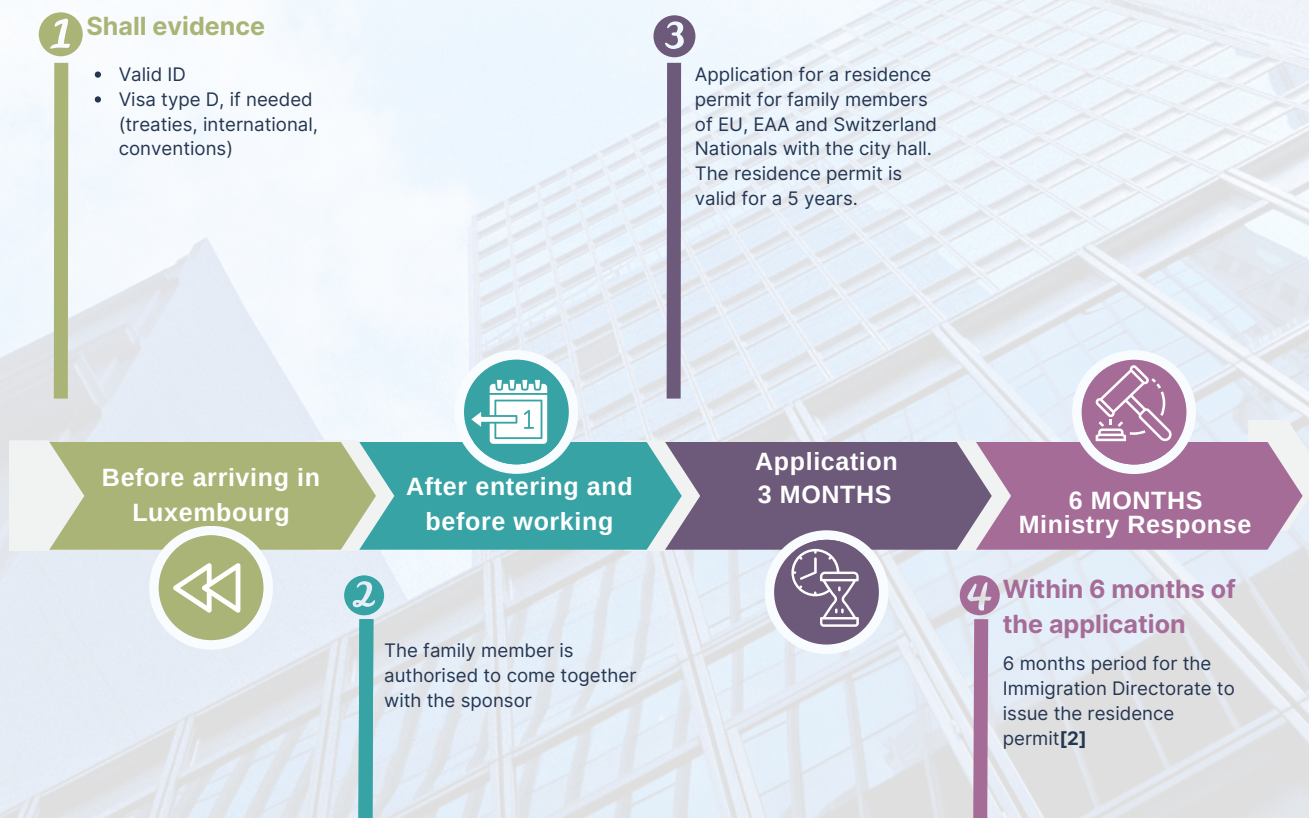
Family members joining a third country national (the "Sponsor")



Family Members: include spouse, registered partner, direct ascendants, indirect ascendants under care and non-registered partner.

Exemption: Family members of blue card holders and transferees workers can regroup immediately and apply for residence and work permit from Luxembourg.

Third country nationals family members joining EU nationals



Family Members: include spouse, registered partner, direct ascendants, indirect ascendants under care and non-registered partner.

Note: Family members have an automatic right to stay permanently if the sponsor himself/herself has a permanent right to stay in Luxembourg.

Exemption to work permit: spouse, registered partner or child of a EU, EAA and Switzerland nationals who is already working in Luxembourg do not require a work permit.
